All applications to the First Year Group in Enfield Community College will only be accepted after 1st October 2024 @ 09:00 and the closing date for receipt of applications is the 22nd October 2024 at 16:00. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

All transfer applications to the Second, Third, TY or Fifth Year Groups in Enfield Community College, other than to the Special Class, will only be accepted after the 28/April/2025 and the closing date for receipt of applications is the 19/05/2025 by 3pm. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

Please be reminded that, in line with the school's Admission Policy and the Education (Admission to Schools) Act 2018, all waiting lists going forward are only in place for the academic year to which they apply. Therefore, if a student is seeking a place in the Special Class and is not successful in a given academic year or is on a waiting list for this year, a new application must be made for the following year.
